Co-opbank Persatuan launches takaful plan for haj, umrah pilgrims

KUALA LUMPUR: Koperasi Bank Persatuan Malaysia Berhad (Co-opbank Persatuan) has launched a takaful plan for haj and umrah pilgrims in collaboration with Sun Life Malaysia Takaful Berhad.

Its chairman Datuk Yusra Sabar said the takaful scheme had obtained approval from the Malaysian Cooperative Commission (SKM).

scheme also offered the ‘Badal Haji’ (haj pilgrimage service) should any untoward incidents occurred to the person insured.

Meanwhile, Henry, in his speech, said the collaboration was seen as a smart move and rationale in order to enhance the country’s economic sector.
